- Jim Charlier presented an overview of the Koloa-Poipu Circulation Plan using a Powerpoint presentation. Jim emphasized the intent of the CAI team to prepare the plan through the collaborative efforts of residents, developers, Kaua'i County staff and other stakeholders that would result in common ownership of the transportation plan.
- Members also noted that the plan will address one of the primary concerns of the recently completed PBRA Mission Statement involving transportation and mobility.
- PBRA members voiced their interest and concerns that the PBRA vision statement be incorporated within the plan. An important aspect is broadening the appeal of the area as a visitor destination by creating more activities, such as biking and hiking.
- PBRA members expressed their desire to help with the resort employees survey and would coordinate with the CAI team the following week.
- Other issues and concerns discussed included implementation and funding for the transportation plan. Jim noted that there are existing federal and other revenue streams that can be leveraged for trails, buses, etc.
- The PBRA board was receptive to the plan and had many encouraging comments.
